Requests 1 to 3:

Q1. *How many senior officers are provided with their own transport for business and private use, broken down by rank in your police authority?*

A1. The Chief Constable, Deputy Chief Constable and two Assistant Chief Constables are each provided with a lease car.

Q2. *What is the total level of capital balances held at the end of the last financial year for your police authority; and what percentage of gross income did this represent for the police force?*

A2. The Authority Treasurer has spoken to you regarding this to clarify your request. The figures he has provided show that capital grant and contributions not applied at 31 March 2005 were £283,000.00 which represents 0.18% of gross income.

Q3. *In your police authority, how many police officers are currently suspended for (a) less than three months, (b) more than six months, (c) more than twelve months and (d) more than 24 months, broken down by rank?*

A3. The Authority only has information for senior officers (Assistant Chief Constable and above). None of our senior officers are suspended.
