Report Title: Appointment of a DCC Regional Collaboration

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT.

1. To inform Members of the appointment of ACC Peter Goodman (Derbyshire Constabulary) as Deputy Chief Constable Regional Collaboration.

INFORMATION AND ANALYSIS.

2. A regional appointments panel consisting of Mrs J Birkin Chairman (Derbyshire Police Authority), Mrs G Goucher MBE (Derbyshire Police Authority), Cllr J Williams (Derbyshire Police Authority), with Mr Tim Render (Leicestershire Police Authority), Cllr Barry Young (Lincolnshire Police Authority), Mr Robert Wootton (Northamptonshire Police Authority) and Mrs Gill Harrison (Nottinghamshire Police Authority) in attendance, met on Tuesday 12th January hosted by Derbyshire Police Authority at the Makeney Hall Hotel, Milford, Derbyshire. The Chief Constables Derbyshire Constabulary and Nottinghamshire Police and HMI Zoe Billingham provided advice and Mr S C Bate OBE, Chief Executive Derbyshire Police Authority provided executive office support.

2. There were two candidates, both of whom were cleared through the Senior Appointments Panel and the Home Secretary.

3. The process involved each candidate making a presentation, providing a briefing on an exercise scenario and being interviewed. Additionally each candidate was psychologically profiled by the NPJA.

4. Full details of the process including details of the scoring mechanism and results are held by Derbyshire Police Authority and are available for members from the Chief Executive if required.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

5. We are still awaiting the finalised account from the Makeney Hall hotel; this will be forwarded to the Collaboration Programme Team, once received. The overall cost of the complete process will be in the region of £980.

6. The costs of the post (including package, pension etc) will be shared between the 5 forces on the formula grant split that we have worked to for some time. A schedule will be tabled at the meeting. In order to formalise that arrangement, an agreement pursuant to the new collaboration provisions in the Police and Crime Act 2009 is being produced and will be signed off by the Chief Executives on behalf of the 5 Police Authorities, and by the 5 Chief Constables.
