SUBJECT **POLICING PLAN – THREE QUARTER YEAR UPDATE**

Purpose of Report

1. This report is submitted to advise the Police Authority of the third quarter performance against the 2009/10 focus year of the Policing Plan.

Background

2. The Police Act 1996 as inserted by the Police and Justice Act 2006 places a requirement on the Police Authority set a 3 year Policing Plan. The plan must be refreshed each year to ensure that it is current and fit for purpose for the focus year.
3. The Policing Plan sets out how the Police Authority will deliver policing and protective services within their area, what financial resources will be available, how they will collaborate, how they will improve, how they will measure success and how they are exercising their duties under the Crime and Disorder Act 1998. The current Leicestershire Constabulary Policing Plan was set in 2009 for the three year period 2009-2012.
4. Performance against the focus year of the Policing Plan is subject of quarterly reports to Police Authority. The end of year report is encompassed in the Annual Report.
5. The Publications Panel has agreed that an edited version of the Annual Report for performance against the 2009/10 focus year of the Policing Plan will be included in the Local Policing Summaries.

Current Position

6. Attached at Appendix 1 is the third quarter performance of the Constabulary against the 2009/10 focus year of the Policing Plan.

Future Steps

7. The full year performance against the Policing Plan, in the form of a draft Annual Report will be submitted to the Publications Panel meeting on 29th April 2010. Although the full end of year performance data will not be finalised in time for this meeting; Police Authority Approval at this stage will be necessary in order to ensure that print dead-lines can be met for an edited version of the Annual Report to be included in the Local Policing Summaries.
8. Subject to Police Authority approval, the finalised Annual Report will be published on the Police Authority and Constabulary websites before 30th June 2010.

Recommendation

The Authority is recommended to:

- approve the three quarter performance report against the 2009/10 focus year of the Policing Plan;
- note the inclusion of an edited version of the Annual Report for 2009/10 in the Local Policing Summaries.
