Subject        **WAYLEAVE AGREEMENT – QUORN POLICE STATION**

## **Purpose of Report**

1. To seek approval to the granting of a wayleave for the erection of one telegraph pole by British Telecommunications Plc on land in the ownership of the Police Authority at Quorn Police Station.
2. To seek approval to the granting of delegated powers to the Chief Constable for wayleave agreements for the future erection of telegraph poles on Police Authority land.

## **Background**

3. British Telecommunications (BT) Plc wish to erect a telegraph pole on Police Authority land adjoining Quorn Police Station. BT has the right to erect such equipment under Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 (as amended).
4. Accordingly, it has been provisionally agreed to grant a wayleave to BT for the purposes of erecting the pole.
5. The siting of the pole will not interfere with the operational use of the station.
6. In addition it is considered appropriate that the Chief Constable be granted delegated authority for the future approval of the siting of such telegraph poles.

## **Proposal**

7. BT propose to erect telegraph pole on Police Authority land adjoining Quorn Police Station.

## **Recommendations**

8. Members are recommended to approve the provisionally agreed wayleave with BT for the erection of a telegraph pole on land in the ownership of the Police Authority at Quorn Police Station.
9. Members are recommended to approve the granting of delegated powers to the Chief Constable for the agreement of wayleaves in the future for the erection of telegraph poles.
