I joined Leicestershire Police Authority on 1 October 2008

I completed the initial induction and introduction meetings with key Authority and Force officers.

I undertook member training courses on Equality and Diversity (2 days), effective scrutiny (half day), the role of an audit committee (half day), and Chief Police Officer recruitment (half day).

I had 100% attendance at Authority , committee (Finance and General Purposes, Audit, Remuneration) , panel (Strategic Finance, Performance) and informal Authority meetings between October 2008 and March 2009, with particular involvement and contributions on finance matters.

I have worked as one of four Authority members of Strategic Finance Group to develop budget proposals that were accepted by Authority in February 2009.

I contributed to various outside events, representing the Authority, including North West Leicestershire Crime and Disorder Reduction Partnership, jobs recruitment day, and liaised with elected authority members for my home area (Hinckley and Bosworth) on police and other community matters.
